

More Places to Redeem Your HI5 Beverage Containers

Mayor Billy Kenoi, the Department of Environmental Management, and the State Department of Health, announce that residents of Hawai`i Island now have more places to redeem their HI5 beverage containers at County of Hawai`i Recycling and Transfer Stations.

Puna residents can now recycle and redeem HI5¢ labeled beverage containers again at the Pāhoa HI⁵ Certified Redemption Center at the Pāhoa Recycling and Transfer Station and on October 3rd at the Volcano HI⁵ Certified Redemption Center at the Volcano Recycling and Transfer Station. Residents in the Hawaiian Ocean View Estates area can now redeem their HI5¢ labeled beverage containers at the newly opened certified redemption center at the Hawaiian Ocean View Estates Recycling and Transfer Station.
